# **VILLAGE OF SIDNEY WATER ACQUISITION**

The Village of Sidney is located in Champaign County, approximately 10 miles from Illinois American Water Champaign County operations. Sidney provides water service to approximately 570 customers.

#### **CHALLENGES**

- **Operational:** The long-time water operator retired and the Village no longer wished to operate the system.
- **Rates:** Village officials were concerned about the capital needed to adequately invest in the local water system, including a new elevated water tank.
- **Financial:** The Village planned to invest in other community needs.

## **SOLUTION**

The Village chose to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) to sell its water system assets. Through the competitive RFP process, Illinois American Water was selected by the Village as the best long-term solution provider for its residents.

## **BENEFITS**

- **Operational:** The systems are staffed with full-time licensed personnel and supported by our Champaign County District.
- **Rates:** Illinois American Water is making a significant investment in Sidney's water and systems, including replacing the elevated water tank. In addition, Illinois American Water lowered water rates by approximately 29 percent.
- **Financial:** The Village received approximately \$2.3 million for its water assets after regulatory approval of the acquisition and at close of sale. This allowed the Village to invest funds into other projects.
